Activity: Adam & Eve Collage

Materials: Adam and Eve figures (included)
Background (included)
Watercolors
Water
Soil
Leaves
Glue
Colors

Instructions:

- Drop a little water on each paint section. Press your thumb (or finger) onto a paint section.
- Make leaves on the tree by pressing your painted thumb (or finger) around the branches. Add as many "leaves" as you like. Let dry.
- While the "leaves" are drying, go outside into God's beautiful world and gather a handful of soil and several leaves. Come back inside!
- Spread a thin layer of glue on the bottom section of the background sheet and sprinkle the soil on the glue. Press gently. Let dry.
- While the soil is drying, color Adam and Eve.
- When the soil is dry, glue Adam and Eve on the background sheet. Glue leaf "clothes" on Adam and Eve. Let dry.
- Show your family your collage and tell them about Adam and Eve.

Activity: God Made Me Self-Portrait

Materials: Self-Portrait Frame sheet (included)
Mirror
Watercolors or Crayons or Colored Pencils or Markers

Instructions:

- Take a look in the mirror - look at your face!! Your face is similar to others because you have eyes, and a nose, and a mouth. But your face is unique, too - you might have blue eyes or green, a short nose or a long nose, a big smile or a small grin. You are the only one in the WORLD with YOUR face!!
- Draw your self-portrait in the frame.
- Thank God that he made each one of us special!!

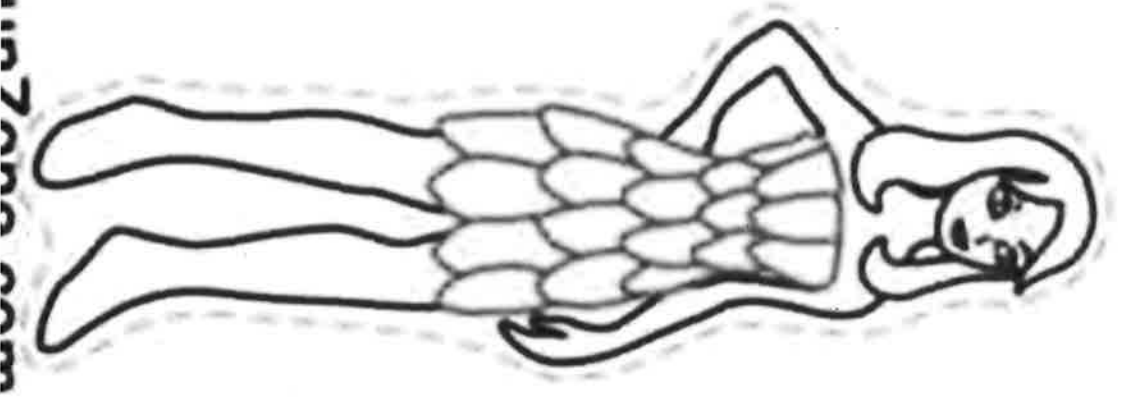
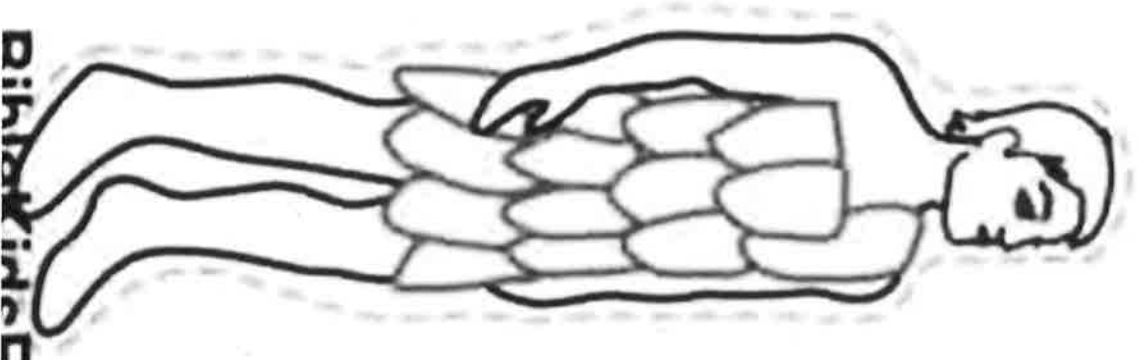
The Lord's Prayer

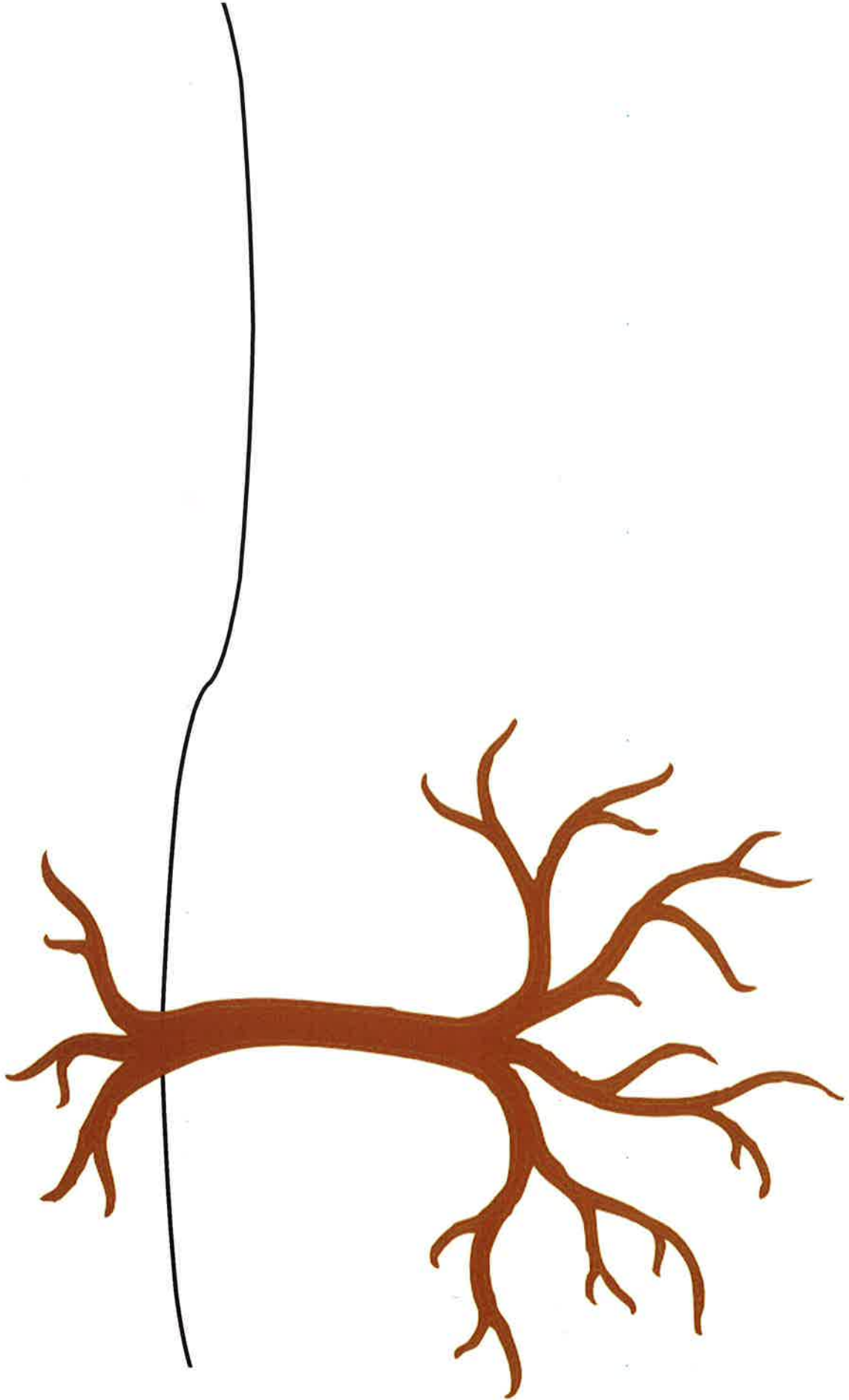
Closing Prayer

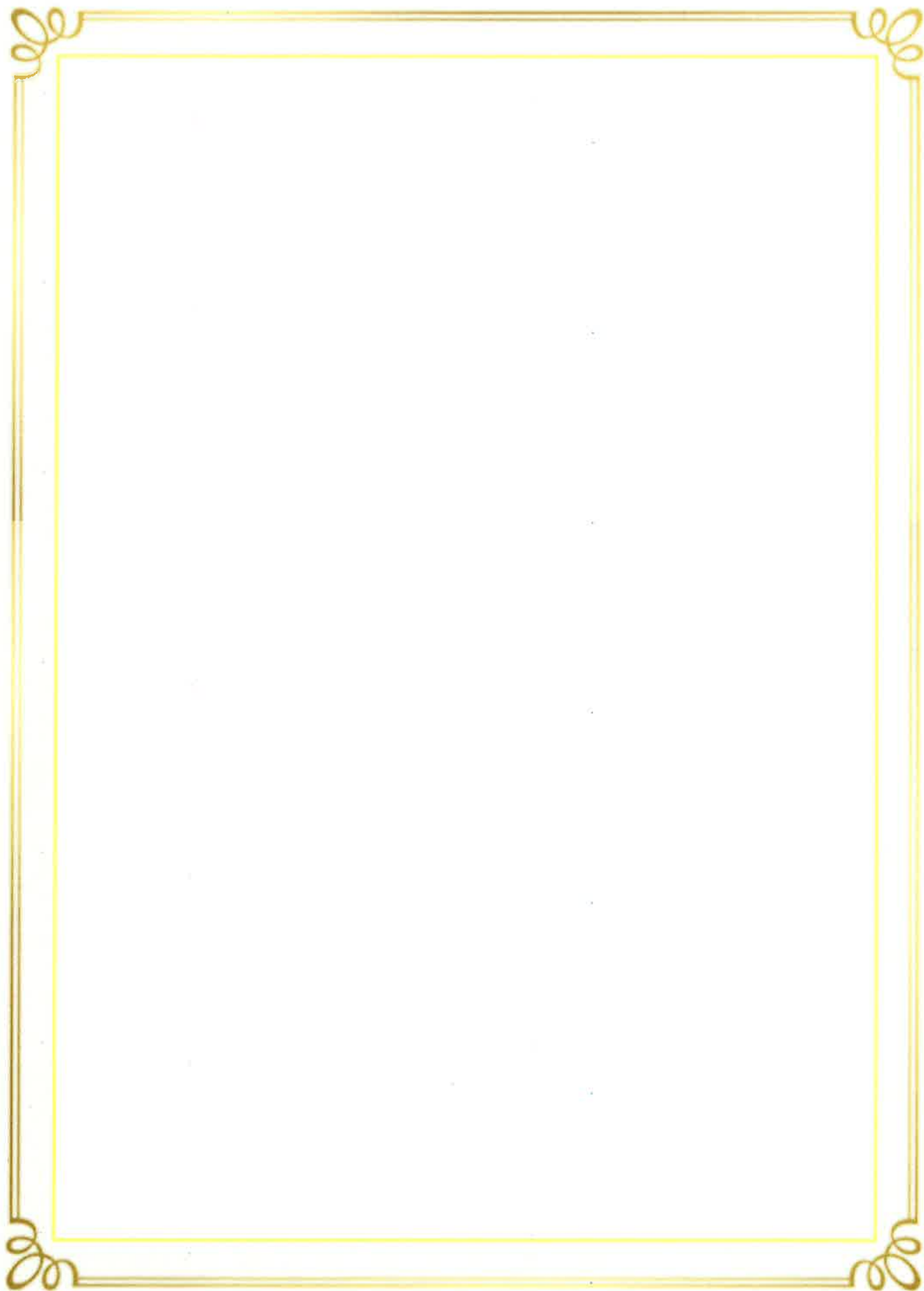
Dear God, *(fold hands in prayer)*

Activity: Whole Heart Art

Materials: Heart sheet (with your name!!)

Watercolors or Crayons or Colored Pencils or Markers

Instructions:

- Trace your name with a pencil or marker. When you write your name in the middle of the heart, tell God he has your whole heart.
- Decorate your heart with watercolors or crayons or colored pencils or markers.
- Share your Whole Heart Art with your family and tell them that God wants us to make good choices, and one of the best choices we can make is to love God with all our heart.

Activity: Bubbling Over with God's Love

Materials: Bubbles (included)

Instructions:

- Blow bubbles. Lots of bubbles. Blow little bubbles. Blow big bubbles.
- Look at the bubbles - each one looks a little different. Maybe it has lots of color in it or maybe it is almost clear. Maybe it floats slowly, maybe it flies away fast. Just like the bubbles, God created each of us uniquely.
- When you blow your very last bubble, "fill" it with a prayer as you're blowing. Watch it float up and away. The bubble may pop, but your prayer goes straight to God's ears.

Thank you for helping me make good choices *(nod head and smile)*

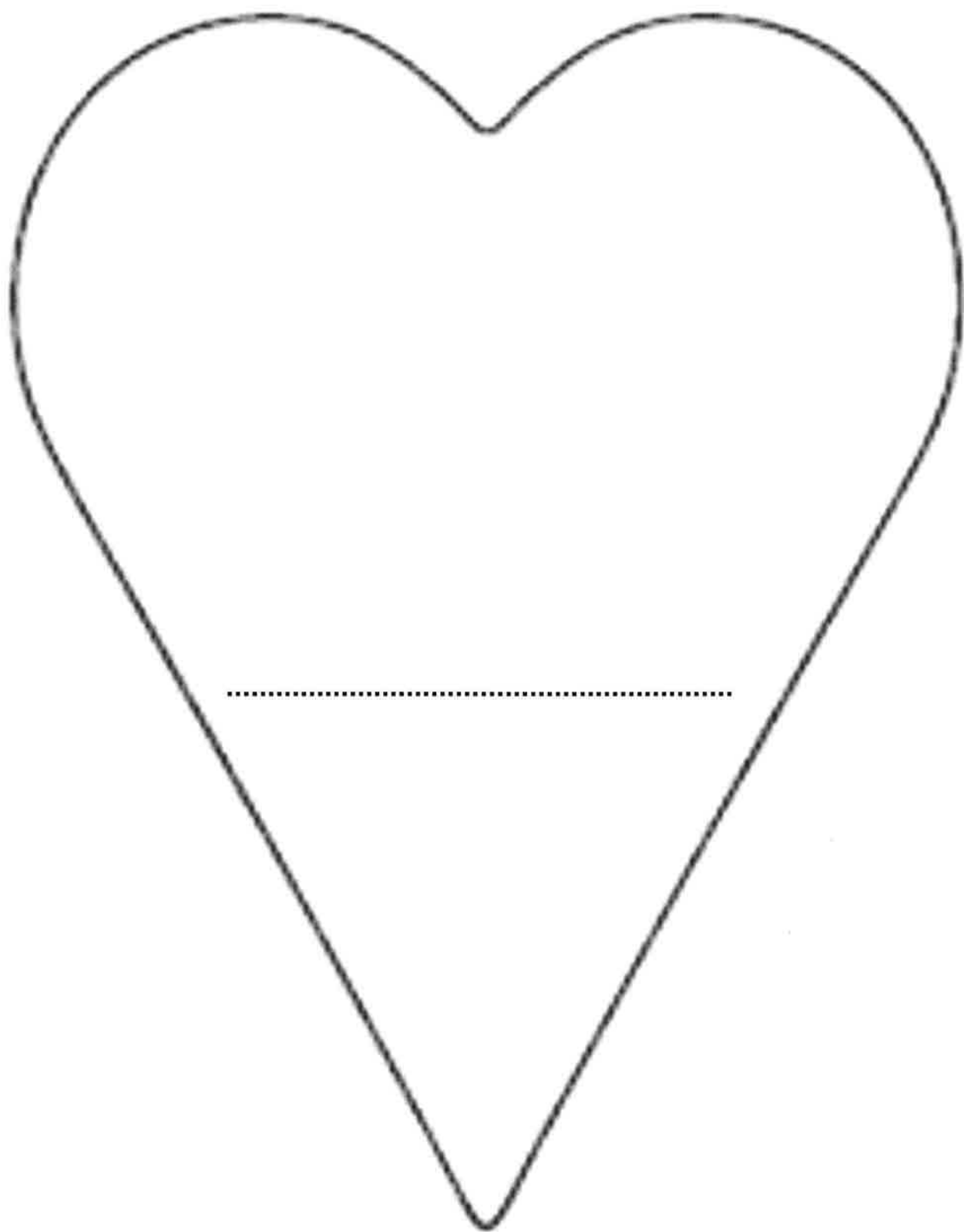
To stay away from sin and wrong. *("push" something away with your hands)*

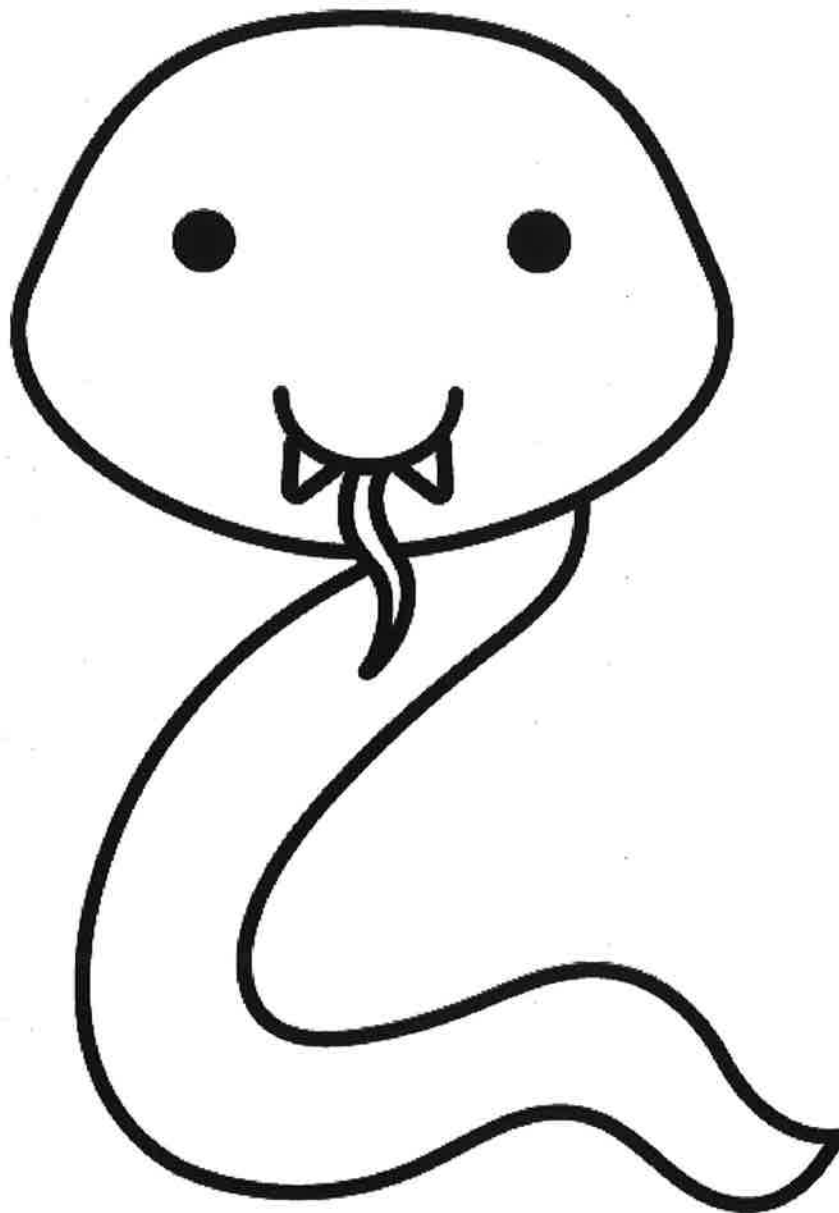

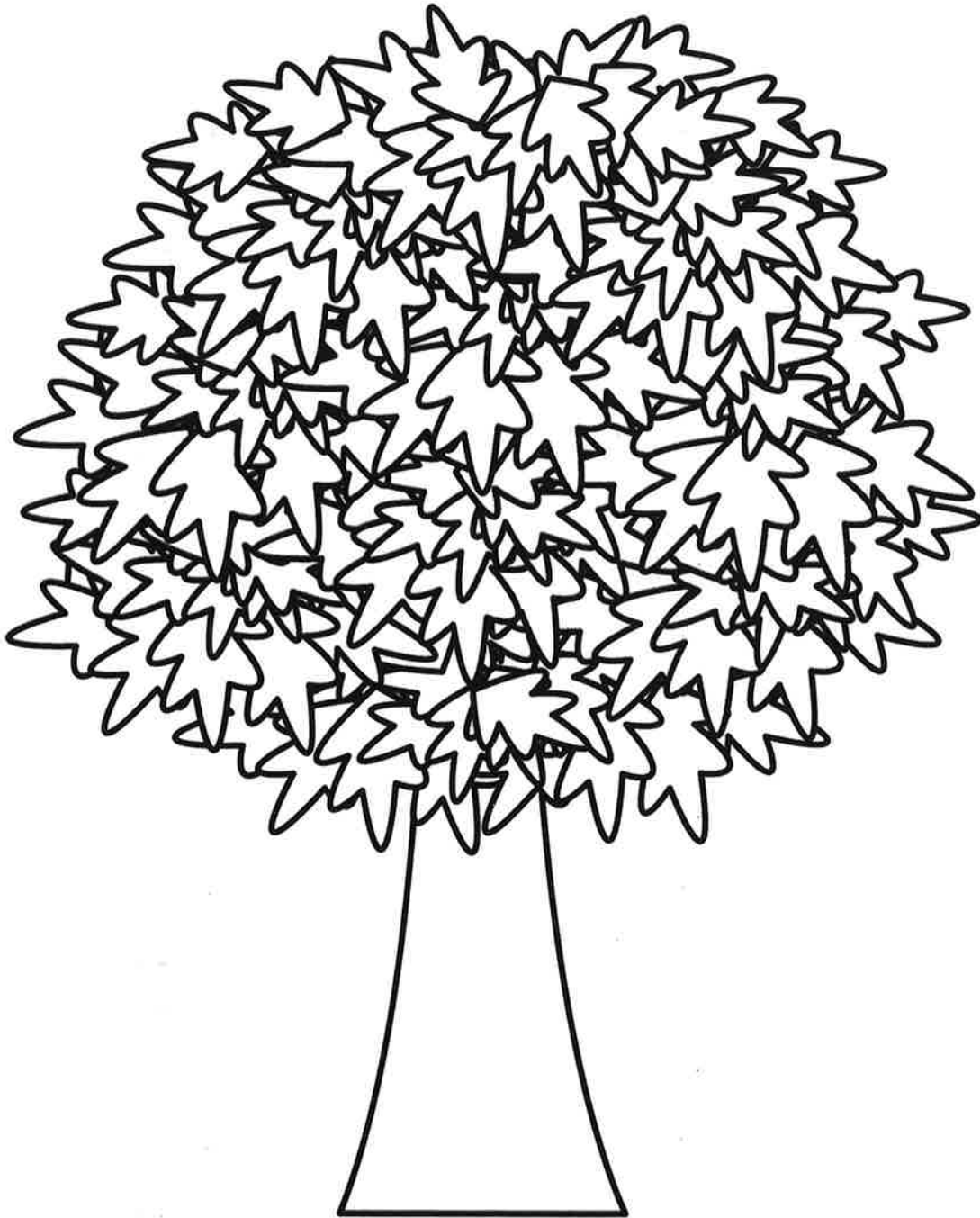
Eve
