"Beginning New Journeys" Teri Talk – May 2025

May 1986 was a banner year in the Sutherlin household. My brother Randy, my father Jim, and I all graduated that year. Randy graduated from High School, Dad earned his Doctor of Theology, and I finished my Bachelor of Science in psychology and religion. Dad and I graduated from Phillips University and Randy from Enid High School in Enid, Oklahoma.

This May, across the country, milestone achievements are being celebrated in graduation ceremonies. Graduation means successfully completing the learning requirements to qualify for a degree, grade, or promotion being worked towards. Today we equate this word with completing education, but it can also mean we have completed our training for our occupation or vocation. Graduation ceremonies are referred to as *commencement*. Commencement means a new beginning, as one journey comes to an end and a new journey starts.

As disciples, we all have the potential for greatness. Jesus said to His disciples then, and he says to us today, 'If you believe in me, you'll do the things I do. Let's remember how much we are loved and let the world know we are disciples of Jesus Christ by the love we show for one another and others because we are loved by God.


