Activity 1: Thankfulness Luminary

Materials: Vellum sheet (included)

Colored pencils (colored pencils work best, but colors or markers

may be used)

Tape

Flameless tea light (included)

Instructions:

- Brainstorm all the things you are thankful for in this life.
- Write words or draw pictures (or both!) to represent all the things you are thankful for.
- Roll your decorated vellum into a tube and secure with a small piece of tape.
- Turn the flameless tea light on, and set the luminary over it.
- Use your luminary as a table centerpiece or place it in your room so you can see it before you go to sleep.

Activity 2: Thankfulness Tree

Materials: Brown construction paper (included)

Pencil

Scissors

White card stock background sheet (included)

Glue

Leaf cut out sheet (included)

Colors, markers, or colored pencils

Instructions:

Trace around your wrist and hand on the brown construction paper

- Cut out your traced hand
- Glue your traced hand on the background sheet
- Brainstorm all the things you are thankful for in this life.
- Write one thankful word on each leaf, then color the leaves
- Cut out the leaves and glue them to the "tree" you "planted" on the background sheet.



Family Activity: Conversation Starters and Thanksgiving Prayer

Before your family gathers at the table for Thanksgiving dinner, cut out each Conversation Starter and place it in a bowl or basket.

When you sit down for dinner, ask your family to listen while you read the Thanksgiving Prayer.

During dinner, pass the bowl or basket to each person and have them choose a Conversation Starter. Discuss each of the topics with your family!

The Apostles' Creed
