

Lenten Promise Plate

Hi 5th and 6th graders,

I saw this simple project on a website and thought it might be a fun way for you to come up with some ideas of things you can do to understand and participate in Lent.

Cut a heart or circle- about 5 inches across- from the colored construction paper and glue it in the center of the back side of the plate. Then glue the black cross in the center of that. Around the heart and cross write some words that describe things you might do to show God you are devoted to Him and you want to get closer to Him during Lent.

Some examples of words you could use are: *worship, praise, read the bible, pray, sing Christian songs, donate time to others, etc.* I have created one for myself and will share with you in our next video.

My video will be created this weekend and posted early next week on the St. John Lutheran Church website. Please look for it next week and learn more about the lesson on commitment to Jesus. I have also included a fun "fortune teller" activity printed with the ten commandments. I will demonstrate how to fold and use that on the video as well!

I hope you are all doing well in school and staying healthy! Take care of yourself and your family, keep praying, and keep following Jesus!!

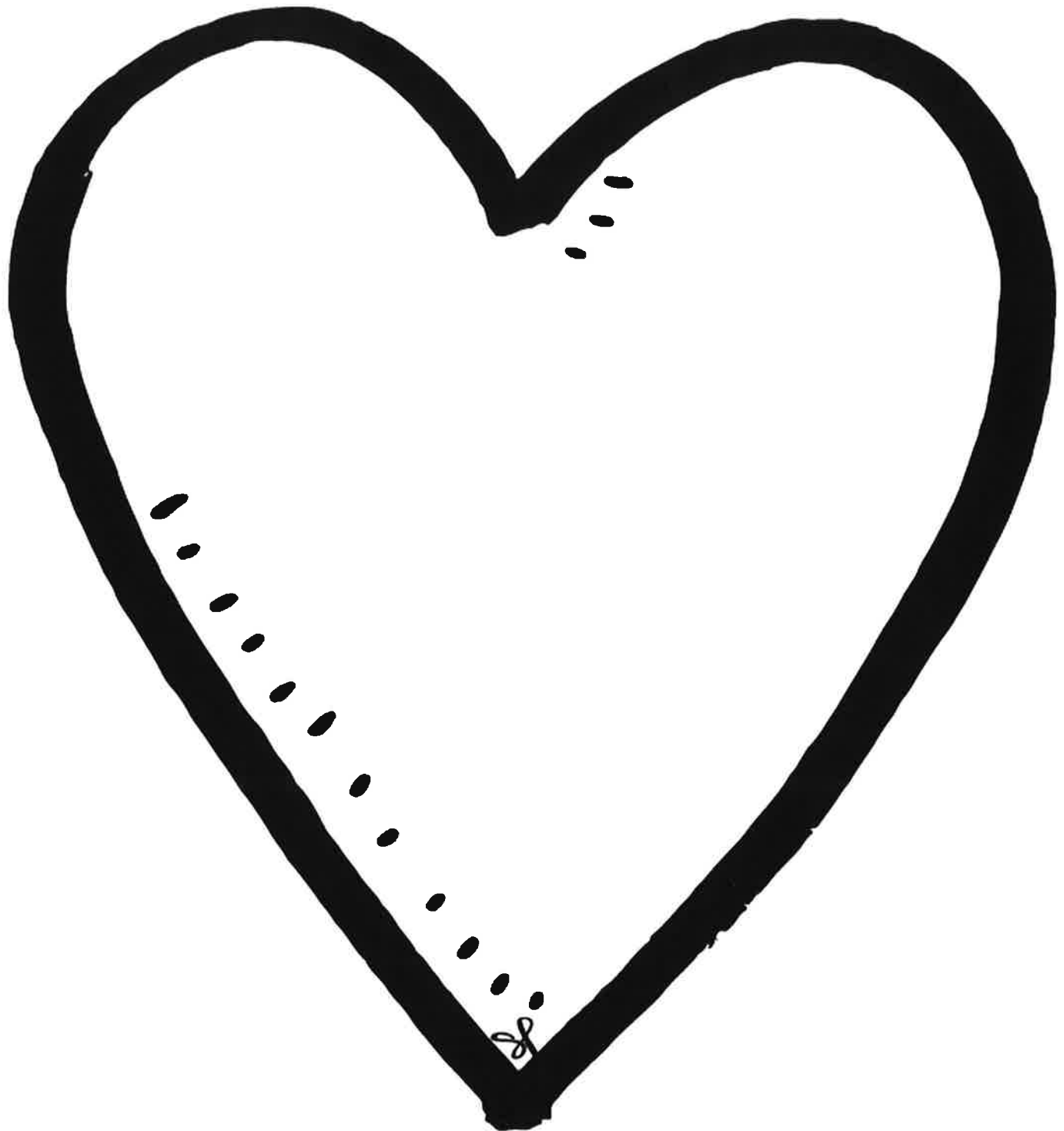
