- Glue cotton balls on the clouds at each end of the rainbow

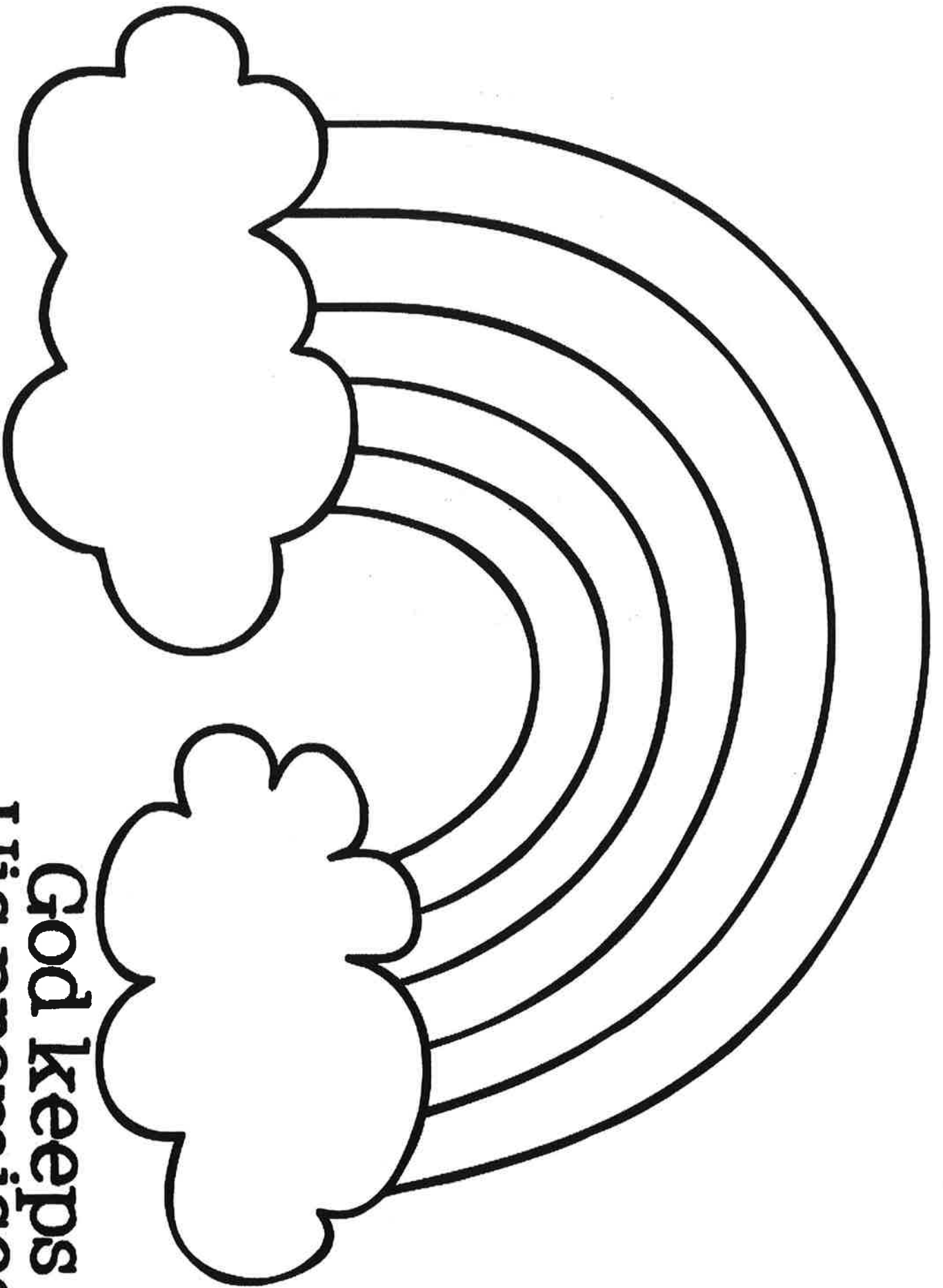
