- All poinsettias must be picked up after Christmas Eve services, or on Thursday, December 26 from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm. All poinsettias remaining after 1:30 pm Thursday, December 26 will be discarded, unless arrangements have been made in advance.
- Poinsettias for homebound members and Heart2Home participants may be of any color or size.
- Poinsettias may be delivered to St. John between Wednesday, December 18 through Monday, December 23 from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm. Heart2Home volunteers will deliver poinsettias between December 21 and 24.
