Activity: Brick Stackin' and Snackin'

Materials: Pretzel sticks (included)
Marshmallows (included)
Plate or tray

Instructions:

- Wash your hands
- Build towers on a clean plate or tray using pretzel sticks and marshmallows
- After you've built several towers, ask a family member to help you build a new tower. Is the new tower stronger or taller? Were you able to make the new tower in less time?

When you asked for help, building a new tower was probably easier. We need God's help, too, and can thank God for always being here to help us! In the Bible, the people of Babel forgot they needed God, but we need God always. We can always pray to God and ask for his help.

When you're done stackin' you can do some snackin'!!

Activity: A Name for God

Materials: Blank sheet of paper (included)
Watercolors (included)

Instructions:

- Lay the blank sheet of paper on the table with the blank side up
- Using watercolors, paint the entire sheet
- As you paint, watch what appears!!

Remember we need God's help, and God is always here for us! We can ask for God's help anytime, anywhere, and about anything. God knows our name, and will help us, just like painting the paper helped God's name appear!

The Lord's Prayer


